- President:

## Building Concerns:

o **High School**: March 8<sup>th</sup>: Threat from student to teacher. Faculty upset with HS admin. Student was allowed to leave in cab and go home unattended. Ultimately the student was arrested, and

teacher has an order of protection. Being home schooled, pending superintendent hearing. Some faculty was not aware of incident for days. Student had been written up and administration did not follow up with student. Behavior report disappeared on Infinite Campus but reappeared when faculty questioned it. Only picture of student is from Instagram. Administration did not call or check on teacher (who was shaken by threat) over the weekend. Superintendent was very open and concerned for faculty member. Superintendent sat with teacher for almost 2 hours.
